1 Competition Procedures

- 1.1 The championship is scheduled to be played over 24 holes of stroke for all players
- 1.2 The field for the event will be limited to 52 players.
- 1.3 Entries will be accepted on an as received basis.
- 1.5 All ties will be decided by:
 - a. Sudden death play off for scratch events holes determined by match committee
 - b. Count back as recommended by Golf Australia for handicap events

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All players must be current financial members of their golf club.
- 2.2 Eligible players are amateurs whose GA Handicap at the time of entry does not exceed 54.0 strokes (women) or 54.0 strokes (men) in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System. Daily handicaps shall not exceed 54 strokes (women) or 54 strokes (men).

3. Entries

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$35.00 (inc. GST) per individual. Breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea is included.
- 3.2 All entries must be received by COB Thursday 14th November 2024 via email events@romseygolfclub.net text or phone.
- 3.3 The Romsey Golf Club shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3.4 The draw for the competition will be available on the day at the Club at registration.

4. Prizes

- 4.1 Prizes will be awarded to:
 - Men: Graeme Clement Open Champion
 - Women: Women's Open Champion
 - Men & Women Scratch, Grade winners -Nett, Handicap, AM & PM handicap
- 4.2 Only one major prize per player
- 4.3 Individual prizes are subject to change dependant on final numbers.

5. Event Committee

- 5.1 The committee shall consist of Romsey Golf Club representatives and the match Committee of the Club. In the absence of a full event committee, such members thereof, as may be present at the time, may give a decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full committee
- 5.2 In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the event committee may shorten the competition or appoint another day for completion.

6.Protests

Protests must be made to the event committee no later than 30 minutes after the conclusion of the competition.

7.Refund Policy

Any entrant may withdraw and have their entry fee refunded providing notification is received within one day prior to the commencement of the event. After this date refunds will be considered on individual cases. In the case of an event not being completed (for example due to weather delays) refunds will not be provided

8.Extreme Weather Policy

9. Motorised Transport

All players are permitted to use motorised transportation without needing to apply to Romsey Golf Club for approval. Please note the club has very limited availability of Golf carts for hire

10 Clubs and balls

List of Conforming Driver Heads: Golf Australia's Model Local Rule G-1 is in effect. Penalty for making a stroke with a club in breach of Local Rule: Disqualification. List of Conforming Golf Balls: Model Local Rule G-3 is in effect. Penalty for breach of the Local Rule: Disqualification.

11 Practice

A player must not practise on the competition course before or between rounds. Exception: All recognised practice areas within the bounds of the course may be used by players for practice on any day of the competition.

12 Distance Measuring Devices

In accordance with Rule of Golf 4.3a(1), a player may obtain distance and direction information by use of a distance-measuring device. The provisions of Rule 4.3 apply in relation to Use of Equipment.

13. Suspension of Play

The following signals will be used to suspend and resume play:

- Immediate stop for imminent danger – one prolonged note of a siren
- Stop for a non-dangerous situation – three consecutive notes of a siren.
- Resumption of play – two consecutive notes of a siren
- Note: When play is stopped for imminent danger, all practice areas will be immediately closed.

14. Returning of scorecard

A player's scorecard is officially returned when it has been handed to a Committee Member or put in the allocated box

15. Results of Competition – Competition is Closed

When the event trophy/prizes is/are presented to the winner/s, the results of the competition are officially announced, and the competition is closed.

16. Anti-Doping Policy

The GA anti-doping policy applies for this event. The GA anti-doping policy is the Australian National Anti-Doping Policy, effective from 1 January 2021, and can be found by [clicking here](#).

17. Player Code of Conduct

18. Local Rules and dress standards

All local rules of the host club and temporary local rules shall stand for the competition unless otherwise notified. The dress regulations of the host club shall apply.
